Vaccination Policy

- The Club rules require a minimum C3 (distemper, hepatitis, and parvovirus) vaccination, administered after the age of twelve weeks, for all puppies less than twelve months old before joining the Club.
 - *Please note – A delay of two weeks after the final puppy vaccination is required before puppies are permitted to join classes. Puppies must be at least 16 weeks old before they attend classes.
- All adult dogs (over twelve months of age) joining or renewing must have had at least a C3 vaccination administered after twelve months of age. Tri-annual (three yearly) vaccination is considered acceptable thereafter.
- As Bordetella and Parainfluenza (both agents causing canine cough) are not generally life threatening to healthy dogs, these vaccinations are not compulsory for members, but are recommended and owners should be reminded that these may be required if the dog is to be boarded in kennels.
- We will accept Titre results for Parvovirus, Hepatitis and Distemper. These must be accompanied by a letter from the Vet stating the diseases the dog has been tested for, if the dog is immune and when they should be re tested.
- All vaccination certificates must be signed by a registered veterinary surgeon.
- Homeopathic “vaccinations” will not be accepted.
